



Coto Family Farms Coffee is grown in the Merendon Mountains of Northwestern Honduras. The exceptional quality of the coffee is due to the environment and the farmers. It is mountain and shade grown, in soil and elevation ideal for coffee plants, and is in a Cloud Forest biome, which means that every evening the clouds come in and give their humidity to the coffee plants. The Coto family has grown and dried coffee with love and care since Mayan times, using the native coffee trees that are best suited for healthy production, and caring well for the land. No pesticides or synthetic fertilizers are used. The coffee is shipped fresh each season to Coto Family Farms in North Carolina, so is family grown and family sold. It is sold exclusively by the family members and for roasting and distribution by Ingenious Coffee Roasters. Because of the truly direct sales, the farmers are now earning a decent wage for their hard work. The Coto family is in the second season of exporting coffee to the USA, and planning on helping their neighbors develop a coffee co-op, so that more farmers in their community can have a better living from their good work, and more folks in our communities can enjoy the delicious brews.
